FUNDING FOR A DEDICATED ACTIVE AGING CENTER TO BE CREATED IN
CORTE MADERA**

WHEREAS, the Town of Corte Madera approved Resolution 24/2014 on July 15, 2014, in support of "Age-Friendly Corte Madera"; and

WHEREAS, the Town endorsed "Age-Friendly Corte Madera" and the Coalition's fundraising endeavors; and

WHEREAS, "Age-Friendly Corte Madera" plans to seek official designation as a 501(c) 3 nonprofit and establish a discrete Building Fund; and

WHEREAS, there has been an increase in the quantity and variety of services and classes requested by residents, and availability of the Corte Madera Community Center is limited in evenings and on weekends; and

WHEREAS, the vision created by "Age-Friendly Corte Madera" also includes a Resource Center for assistance with housing, legal issues, finances, and referrals, as well as a drop-in space to meet, unwind and relax in a comfortable and welcoming setting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council hereby supports "Age-Friendly Corte Madera's" efforts to seek funding for a dedicated Active Aging Center.
