

**RESOLUTION NO. 03/2015**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA ENDORSING THE CORTE MADERA WOMEN'S IMPROVEMENT CLUB AND ALLOWING TEMPORARY BANNER SIGNS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM MARCH 13, 2015 TO MARCH 23, 2015 ADVERTISING THEIR INDOOR "YARD SALE" AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER ON MARCH 21, 2015; AND DETERMINING THAT THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES 15061(B)(3)**

**WHEREAS**, on January 26, 2015, the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club requested permission to place three temporary banner signs in the public right-of-way from March 13, 2015 to March 23, 2015 advertising their Indoor "Yard Sale" at the Community Center on March 21, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club has requested that the Corte Madera Town Council endorse the Indoor "Yard Sale"; and,

**WHEREAS**, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval to the Town Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club's request to endorse the Indoor "Yard Sale" and approves the request to install 4'-tall by 6'-wide temporary banner signs as shown in Attachment A in the public right-of-way in the following three locations: (1) one on Madera Blvd. across from Safeway, (2) one on Redwood Highway at the east end of Wornum Dr., and (3) one on the southeast corner of Corte Madera Ave. and Redwood Ave., subject to the following conditions:

1. The banner signs are permitted to be displayed from March 13, 2015 to March 23, 2015.
2. The applicant shall coordinate with Kevin Kramer, Director of Field Maintenance and Operations, to install and remove the removable hardware and the horizontal banner.

**CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION**


The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).
