

RESOLUTION NO. 22/2017

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA ENDORSING THE REDWOOD HIGH SCHOOL FOUNDATION, AND ALLOWING ONE TEMPORARY BANNER IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM APRIL 19, 2017 TO MAY 19, 2017 PUBLICIZING THE REDWOOD HIGH SCHOOL FOUNDATION GOLF TOURNAMENT AND AUCTION PARTY FUNDRAISER; AND DETERMINING THAT THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES 15061(B)(3)

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2017, the Redwood High School Foundation requested permission to place one temporary banner in the public right-of-way from April 19, 2017 to May 19, 2017, publicizing the Redwood High School Foundation Golf Tournament and Auction Party fundraiser on May 19, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Redwood High School Foundation, which is a non-profit organization that raises funds to support additional programs, equipment, activities and supplies in the areas of Academics, Arts and Athletics at Redwood High School, and serves Corte Madera and surrounding communities; and,

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval to the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the Redwood High School Foundation's request to endorse the Redwood High School Foundation Golf Tournament and Auction Party fundraiser and approves the request to install one 4'-tall by 8'-wide temporary banner as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner sign is permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

April 19, 2017 to May 19, 2017:

- 1 on Redwood Highway at Wornum Drive

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT ("CEQA") DETERMINATION

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).
