

RESOLUTION NO. 18/2017

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA ENDORSING THE CORTE MADERA WOMEN'S IMPROVEMENT CLUB AND ALLOWING TEMPORARY BANNER SIGNS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM APRIL 6, 2017 TO MAY 8, 2017 ADVERTISING THEIR INDOOR "YARD SALE" AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER ON MAY 6, 2017; AND DETERMINING THAT THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES 15061(B)(3)

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2017, the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club requested permission to place three temporary banner signs in the public right-of-way from April 6, 2017 to May 8, 2017 advertising their Indoor "Yard Sale" at the Community Center on May 6, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club has requested that the Corte Madera Town Council endorse the Indoor "Yard Sale"; and,

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval to the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club's request to endorse the Indoor "Yard Sale" and approves the request to install 4'-tall by 6'-wide temporary banner signs as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner signs are permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

April 10, 2017 to April 24, 2017:

- 1 on Madera Blvd., across from Safeway; and
- 1 on Tamal Vista Boulevard at Wornum Dr.

April 6, 2017 to May 8, 2017:

- 1 on the southeast corner of Corte Madera Ave. and Redwood Ave.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).

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
