

RESOLUTION NO. 01/2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA (1) ENDORSING THE TIDALWAVES SWIM TEAM SEASON, (2) ALLOWING A TEMPORARY SIGN IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM JANUARY 17, 2018 TO FEBRUARY 12, 2018 PUBLICIZING TIDALWAVES SWIM TEAM REGISTRATION; AND (3) DETERMINING THAT THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES 15061(B)(3)

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2017, the Tidalwaves Swim Team requested permission to place a temporary banner in the public right-of-way from January 17, 2018 to February 12, 2018, advertising registration for the Tidalwaves Swim Team season; and

WHEREAS, the Tidalwaves Swim Team, which is a non-profit Marin County recreational swim team supported and run through the Larkspur Recreation Department, has requested that the Corte Madera Town Council endorse the Tidalwaves Swim Team season; and,

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval to the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the Tidalwaves Swim Team's request to endorse the Tidalwaves Swim Team season and approves the request to install one 4'-tall by 7'-wide temporary banners as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner signs are permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

January 17, 2018 to February 12, 2018:

- 1 on Tamal Vista Boulevard at Wornum Drive

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT ("CEQA") DETERMINATION

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).

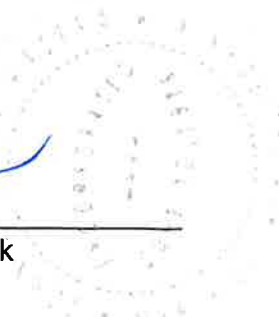
