

RESOLUTION NO. 04/2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA (1) ENDORSING THE REDWOOD HIGH SCHOOL FOUNDATION, (2) ALLOWING A TEMPORARY SIGN IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM FEBRUARY 26, 2018 TO MARCH 23, 2018 PUBLICIZING THE REDWOOD HIGH SCHOOL FOUNDATION GOLF TOURNAMENT AND AUCTION PARTY FUNDRAISER; AND (3) DETERMINING THAT THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES 15061(B)(3)

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2017, the Redwood High School Foundation requested permission to place one temporary banner in the public right-of-way from February 26, 2018 to March 23, 2018, publicizing the Redwood High School Foundation Golf Tournament and Auction Party fundraiser on March 23, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Redwood High School Foundation, which is a non-profit organization that raises funds to support additional programs, equipment, activities and supplies in the areas of Academics, Arts and Athletics at Redwood High School, and serves Corte Madera and surrounding communities; and,

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval to the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the Redwood High School Foundation's request to endorse the Redwood High School Foundation Golf Tournament and Auction Party fundraiser and approves the request to install one 4'-tall by 7'-wide temporary banner as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner sign is permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

February 26, 2018 through March 23, 2018:
• 1 on Redwood Highway at Wornum Drive

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION
