

RESOLUTION NO. 16/2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA
ADOPTING THE FY 2018/19 SB1 PROJECT LIST AND FUNDING OF GAS TAX
EXPENDITURES PER SENATE BILL NO. 1 (SB 1)



WHEREAS, Senate Bill No.1 (SB1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Corte Madera must include a list of all projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, in the Town of Corte Madera fiscal year 2018/19 budget, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, an estimated \$406,328 in RMRA funding is projected to be allocated to Corte Madera in fiscal year 2018/19 from SB1.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The FY 2018/19 SB1 Project List includes the following list of projects planned to be partially funded with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

Project Title: Paradise Drive Multimodal Enhancement Project

Project Description: Enhance pedestrian, bicycle; and vehicular safety along the corridor through reallocation of right-of-way, sidewalk/bike lane improvements, and improved traffic control devices.

Project location: Paradise Drive from San Clemente Avenue to Robin Drive

Proposed Schedule: Begin preliminary work in 2018 and complete the project in phases between 2019 and 2022.

Estimated Useful Life: 30 years.

Project Title: Traffic Control Device Enhancements Project

Project Description: Assess feasibility and implement where appropriate intersection enhancements (re-striping, traffic signals, stop signs, roundabouts, etc.) to improve safety, reduce congestion at 3 locations.

Project location: Madera/Tamal Vista, Nellem/Warnum, Casa Buena Drive at Sanford

Proposed Schedule: Begin assessments in 2018 and complete improvements between 2018 and 2020.

Estimated Useful Life: 50 years for roundabouts and 10 years for re-striping.

Project Title: Tamal Vista Complete Streets Project

Project Description: Implement a multimodal safety enhancement, new road surface, bike lanes, pedestrian crossings, ADA enhancements for the Tamal Vista Bl. corridor.

Project location: Tamal Vista between Madera Avenue and Fifer Avenue.

Proposed Schedule: Begin design in 2018, complete phased work during 2019 and 2020.

Estimated Useful Life: 20 years.

2. The Capital Projects budget for fiscal year 2018/19 includes the following:
Increase appropriations in the amount of approximately \$406,328 to be deposited into a separate fund upon receipt of monies from the State Controller's Office. Expenditures on projects financed by these new revenues to be charged to this fund.
3. The recitals stated above are found to be true and correct and constitute the findings of the Town Council made in support of this resolution.
