

RESOLUTION NO. 34/2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO SUBMIT A LETTER OF SUPPORT TO THE TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY OF MARIN TO APPLY FOR FUNDING FROM CYCLE 4 OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM FOR THE NORTH SOUTH GREENWAY BIKE PATH SOUTHERN SEGMENT

WHEREAS, the Transportation of Marin has sponsored a number of projects throughout the County that create or improve non-motorized transportation facilities that promote sustainable forms of mobility; and

WHEREAS, public agencies and local bicycle advocates have pursued creating a network of multi-use paths, primarily for pedestrian and bicycle use only, from the Golden Gate Bridge north to the Sonoma County line referred to as the "North-South Greenway;" and

WHEREAS; The concept of the North-South Greenway is referenced in multiple Agency's Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan, including the Town of Corte Madera's Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan of 2016, and is considered a high priority project; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Authority of Marin in partnership with the Town of Corte Madera has been actively developing a new multi-use path over many years to close an existing gap in the North-South Greenway referred to as the "Southern Segment;"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Council of the Town of Corte Madera authorizes the Town Manager to send a letter of support to the Transportation Authority of Marin indicating support of the North-South Greenway (Southern Segment) and support for the implementation plan for a grant application for funding from Cycle 4 of the State of California Active Transportation Program (ATP).
