

RESOLUTION NO. 35/2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA (TOWN) AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO SUBMIT A LETTER OF SUPPORT TO THE CITY OF LARKSPUR TO APPLY FOR FUNDING FROM CYCLE 4 OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (ATP)

WHEREAS, the City of Larkspur has developed a project (PROJECT) called the Doherty Drive Safe Pathways Project that will improve non-motorized transportation facilities to promote bicycle and pedestrian mobility and one includes TOWN right of way; and

WHEREAS, the PROJECT will improve safety for all road users and will include bicycle and pedestrian improvements leading into the intersection of Doherty Drive and Lucky Drive if funds are awarded from the Active Transportation Program (ATP) and includes an allowance for the installation of two roundabouts if deemed feasible; and

WHEREAS; the PROJECT will improve pedestrian and bicycle facilities at the intersections, includes a new bike path on the south side of Doherty Drive from Lucky Drive to the westerly Riviera Circle entrance, as well as intersection improvements, and will also provide new and direct pedestrian connections to Redwood High School and the High Canal Trail via a pedestrian and bicycle trail, including the connection that the High Canal Trail affords to a future Bay Trails network; and

WHEREAS, the City of Larkspur and the Town of Corte Madera have been developing safety improvements for all road users over many years, and both jurisdictions have significant numbers of residents that bike, walk, and use our connected trail networks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council authorizes sending a letter to the City of Larkspur indicating the Town's support of the PROJECT and supports a grant application for funding from Cycle 4 of the State of California Active Transportation Program, and the TOWN agrees to partner in all ways possible to implement the PROJECT.
