

THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA IS SEEKING APPLICANTS FOR THE MARIN/SONOMA MOSQUITO & VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT

Notice is given that the Town of Corte Madera is seeking applications from Corte Madera residents to serve as the Town's representative on the Board of Trustees for the Marin/Sonoma Mosquito & Vector Control District (MSMVCD) for either a two or four-year term to expire on December 31, 2016 or 2018, respectively. The main purpose of the Board of Trustees of the MSMVCD is to organize and carry out an effective mosquito and vector control program and to develop a budget adequate to staff and support the program. Preference for the appointment will be given to a person with strong interest in the prevention, elimination or control of mosquitoes and other arthropods known to be potential carriers of infectious diseases, or presenting a public nuisance.

The Board of Trustees meets on the second Wednesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. at District Headquarters, 595 Helman Lane, Cotati, CA. The following update was received from the Marin County Free Library regarding upcoming renovations and temporary closure for the Corte Madera Library:

The Corte Madera branch of the Marin County Free Library is closing from Thursday, November 27 through Monday, December 15 for the final phase of a major renovation project to improve services and make aesthetic upgrades.

The library will be re-opening on Tuesday, December 16. The remodel will feature renovations to the teen area, lobby area and technology upgrades. There will be a new single information desk to address all patron needs, new check-out stations, including one in the Children's Room, and improved accessibility. An expanded holds pick-up area and interior book return will add convenience. New chairs and counter will be in the teen area, and new lounge seating in the alcoves.

The lobby and new/high demand materials area will be more open and bright, with shelving that makes browsing a breeze. The improved layout of materials in the library stacks will make finding what you want easier. Our friendly, expert staff will be here to assist, as always.

- During the renovation, materials placed on hold may be picked up in the Corte Madera Library Meeting Room from 3-7 pm on December 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, and 10.
- The library will be unable to take any book returns during the closure and the book return will be closed. Please return library materials to any other [MARINet library](#).
- There will be no programs during the closure.
- No book donations will be accepted, but donations may be dropped off at the Friends of the Library Book Place at 1608 Grant Ave. in Novato.

Access to eBooks and other electronic resources are always available 24/7. All other [branches](#) of the Marin County Free Library will remain open.

The project is funded from Measure A, a \$49-per-parcel measure that was approved by 74% of voters in 2010. Funds from the five-year tax allow branches to make structural improvements, extend library hours, hire new staff and provide programming for children, teens and seniors. Extensive upgrades have already been made at Novato, Marin City, Point Reyes, Inverness, Civic Center and Fairfax branches with Measure A funds.
