Notice is hereby given that a General Municipal Election is to be held in the Town of Corte Madera on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, at which time there will be submitted to the voters the following measure:

<p><i>Shall the measure to continue for four more years the special tax for paramedic and/or emergency medical services at the existing annual amount of \$75 per residence and per 1,000 square feet of floor area for nonresidential uses for fiscal years 2019-2020 through 2022-2023, with anticipated annual revenues of \$500,000, and with the appropriations limit increasing by the amount of the tax, be adopted?</i></p>	YES

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 2, Division 9 of the State Elections Code, the legislative body of the town, or any member or members thereof authorized by the body, or any individual voter or bona fide associations, may file a written argument to the Corte Madera Town Clerk, 300 Tamalpais Drive, Corte Madera, CA by August 20, 2018 at 5:00p.m., not exceeding 300 words in length, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) or, if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, for or against the Town measure, and comply with the requirements of Elections Code section 9287(e).

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Town Council has determined that rebuttal arguments, as submitted by the authors of the opposing direct arguments, must be filed with the Town Clerk by August 27, 2018 at 5:00p.m., and shall not exceed 250 words in length.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that any ordinance, impartial analysis, or direct argument or rebuttal argument filed under the authority of the Election Code will be available for public examination in the Town Clerk's Office for not less than 10 calendar days from the deadline(s) for filing arguments and rebuttal arguments.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, the polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
