

RESOLUTION NO. 36/2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA (1) ENDORSING SPARK (LARKSPUR-CORTE MADERA SCHOOLS FOUNDATION), (2) ALLOWING THREE TEMPORARY SIGNS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM AUGUST 23, 2018 TO SEPTEMBER 23, 2018 PUBLICIZING THE SPARK FOUNDATION'S ANNUAL "FUN RUN"; AND (3) DETERMINING THAT THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES 15061(B)(3).

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2018, SPARK (Larkspur-Corte Madera Schools Foundation) requested permission to install three banner signs in the public right-of-way from August 23, 2018 to September 23, 2018, publicizing the SPARK Annual Fun Run fundraiser; and

WHEREAS, the SPARK Foundation is a non-profit parent-led organization whose mission is to raise funds for three local schools: Cove Elementary, Neil Cummins Elementary, and Hall Middle School; with fundraisers such as the Annual "Fun Run" raising money to help fund the schools' programs like science, art, and music, plus keep class sizes small; and

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the SPARK Foundation's request to endorse the SPARK Annual Fun Run fundraiser and approves the request to install three 4'-tall by 7'-wide temporary banner signs as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner signs are permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

August 23, 2018 – September 23, 2018:

- Location #1 – Tamal Vista Blvd at the end of Wornum Dr.
- Location #2 – Redwood Ave. near Montecito Dr., south of the bus shelter;

August 23, 2018 – September 13, 2018:

- Location #3 – On Redwood Hwy. at the end of Wornum

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).
