

RESOLUTION NO. 38/2018

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA IN
SUPPORT OF UNITED STATES BIKE ROUTE 95 ON THE PACIFIC COAST**

WHEREAS, bicycle tourism is a growing industry in North America, contributing \$47 billion a year to the economies of communities that provide facilities for such tourists; and

WHEREAS, the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) has designated a corridor crossing California to be developed as United States Bike Route 95 (USBR 95); and

WHEREAS, the Adventure Cycling Association and the California Bicycle Coalition, with the cooperation of Caltrans, have proposed a specific route to be designated as USBR 95, a map of which is herein incorporated into this resolution by reference; and

WHEREAS, the proposed route for USBR 95 comes through Town of Corte Madera and can therefore provide benefit to our local businesses; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Corte Madera hereby expresses its approval and support for the development of USBR 95, and requests that Caltrans work to obtain the designation from AASHTO, and authorizes the posting of signs within the Corte Madera right-of-way identifying the route through the Town once the official designation has been made.


