

**RESOLUTION NO. 51/2018**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA (1) ENDORSING THE FRIENDS OF THE LARKSPUR LIBRARY, (2) ALLOWING TWO TEMPORARY SIGNS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM SEPTEMBER 19, 2018 TO OCTOBER 13, 2018 PUBLICIZING THE FRIENDS OF THE LARKSPUR LIBRARY'S "WHAT'S IT WORTH" FUNDRAISER; AND (3) DETERMINING THAT THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES 15061(B)(3).

**WHEREAS**, on August 21, 2018, the Friends of the Larkspur Library requested permission to install two banner signs in the public right-of-way from September 19, 2018 to October 13, 2018, publicizing the Friends of the Larkspur Library's "What's It Worth" Fundraiser; and

**WHEREAS**, the Friends of the Larkspur Library's mission is to raise funds to support the Larkspur Library's enrichment programs and cultural events for children, teens and adults in the Larkspur and Corte Madera communities, and to support the purchase of new books, materials and technology for the Library; with fundraisers such as the "What's It Worth" event contributing it's proceeds to fund these efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the Friends of the Larkspur Library's request to endorse the Friends of the Larkspur Library's "What's It Worth" Fundraiser and approves the request to install two 4'-tall by 7'-wide temporary banner signs as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner signs are permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

September 19, 2018 to October 13, 2018:

- Location #1 – on Redwood Ave near Montecito Dr., south of the bus shelter

September 24, 2018 to October 13, 2018:

- Location #2 – on Tamal Vista Blvd at the end of Wornum Dr.

**CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION**

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).




