

RESOLUTION NO. 61/2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA (1) ENDORSING THE TWIN CITIES GIRLS SOFTBALL LEAGUE, (2) ALLOWING TEMPORARY SIGNS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM NOVEMBER 6, 2018 TO DECEMBER 15, 2018 PUBLICIZING REGISTRATION FOR THE UPCOMING SEASON; AND (3) DETERMINING THAT THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES 15061(B)(3).

WHEREAS, on October 24, 2018, Twin Cities Girls Softball requested permission to install two banner signs in the public right-of-way from November 6, 2018 to December 15, 2018, publicizing the registration period for the Twin Cities Girls Softball League's upcoming season; and

WHEREAS, Twin Cities Girls Softball is the official Recreational Softball League for Corte Madera and Larkspur, and has served the community for over 30 years; and

WHEREAS, Twin Cities Girls Softball League's mission is to provide a safe, positive learning environment in which the girls of Twin Cities can learn about and participate in the sport of fast-pitch softball, while also gaining self-esteem, self-confidence and self-discipline; and

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby endorse the Twin Cities Girls Softball League and approves the request to install two 4'-tall by 6'-wide temporary banner signs as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner signs are permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

November 6, 2018 – December 15, 2018:

- Location #1 – On Redwood Avenue near Montecito Drive, south of the bus shelter
- Location #2 – On Tamal Vista Boulevard at the West end of Wornum Drive

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).
