**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA  
COUNCIL ACCEPTING THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA GREENHOUSE GAS  
INVENTORY FOR COMMUNITY EMISSIONS (2016) AND GOVERNMENT  
OPERATIONS EMISSIONS (2015)**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 3 - Resource Conservation and Sustainability of the Corte Madera General Plan contains specific sections which discuss Climate Change, its causes and potential impacts and Community Sustainability. It also contains goals, policies and implementation programs to establish visions for a sustainable Corte Madera; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.7 of the Resource Conservation and Sustainability chapter of the Corte Madera General Plan identifies the Town's primary use of non-renewable energy sources and outlines goals, policies and implementation programs to reduce the consumption of non-renewable energy sources; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.10 Solid Waste Management and Recycling outlines goals, policies and implementation measures to increase recycling participation by Town residents and businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.11 Natural Area Resource Conservation outlines goals, policies and implementation measures to develop sustainable resource management practices; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.12 Water Quality outlines goals, policies and implementation measures to protect, restore and enhance the quality of surface and groundwater resources to meet the needs of all beneficial uses; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.14 Air Quality outlines goals, policies and implementation measures to attain the required Air Quality standards in the San Francisco Bay Air Basin; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2009, the Town of Corte Madera accepted Corte Madera's 2005 Greenhouse Gas Emissions Inventory; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Corte Madera participates in the Marin Climate and Energy Partnership (MCEP) and collaborated with the MCEP Sustainability Coordinator to prepare an updated Greenhouse Gas Emissions Inventory titled - *Town of Corte Madera Greenhouse Gas Inventory for Community emissions (2016) and Government Operations Emissions (2015)*; and

**WHEREAS**, this Resolution is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Guidelines Section 15060(c)(2), as the activity will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment; and Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3) as the activity is not a project as defined in Guidelines Section 15378, because it has no potential for resulting in physical change to the environment directly or indirectly.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, on December 18, 2018, the Corte Madera Town Council held a public hearing regarding the *Town of Corte Madera Greenhouse Gas Inventory for*

*Community emissions (2016) and Government Operations Emissions (2015)* and accepted the report as presented.


