

RESOLUTION NO. 05/2019

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA (1) ENDORSING THE REDWOOD HIGH SCHOOL FOUNDATION ANNUAL FUNDRAISER, (2) ALLOWING A TEMPORARY SIGN IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM FEBRUARY 6, 2019 TO MARCH 22, 2019 PUBLICIZING THE ANNUAL REDWOOD HIGH SCHOOL FOUNDATION "RODEO PARTY AND AUCTION" FUNDRAISER ON MARCH 29, 2019; AND (3) DETERMINING THAT THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES 15061(B)(3).

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2019, the Redwood High School Foundation requested permission to install one banner sign in the public right-of-way from February 6, 2019 to March 22, 2019, publicizing the annual Redwood High School Foundation "Rodeo Party and Auction" Fundraiser on March 29, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Redwood High School Foundation is a non-profit organization that raises funds through events such as the "Rodeo Party and Auction" to support additional programs, equipment, activities and supplies in the areas of Academics, Arts and Athletics at Redwood High School and serves Corte Madera and surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby endorse the annual Redwood High School Foundation "Rodeo Party and Auction" Fundraiser and approves the request to install one 4'-tall by 7'-wide temporary banner sign as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner sign is permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

February 6, 2019 – March 22, 2019:

- Location #1 – On Tamal Vista Boulevard at the West end of Wornum Drive

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).



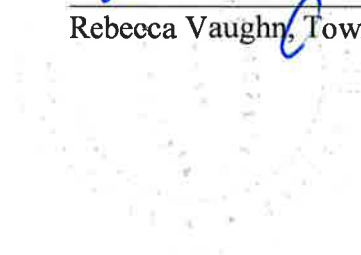
