

RESOLUTION NO. 12/2019

A Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Corte Madera (1) Endorsing the Spark (Larkspur-Corte Madera Schools Foundation) Annual Spring Fundraising Gala, (2) Allowing two Temporary Signs in the Public Right-of-Way from April 23, 2019 to May 4, 2019 Publicizing the Annual Spark Spring Gala “Kentucky Derby Party” Fundraiser on May 4, 2019; and (3) Determining that the Project is Exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines 15061(B)(3)

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2019, Spark (Larkspur-Corte Madera Schools Foundation) requested permission to install two temporary banner signs in the public right-of-way from April 23, 2019 to May 4, 2019, publicizing the Annual Spark Spring Gala “Kentucky Derby Party” Fundraiser on May 4, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Spark (Larkspur-Corte Madera Schools Foundation) is a non-profit organization that raises funds through events such as the “Kentucky Derby Party” to help fund Music, Art, Science, Technology, Engineering, Robotics, and Mindfulness programs at three Corte Madera and Larkspur schools: Cove Elementary, Neil Cummins Elementary, and Hall Middle School; and

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby endorse the Spark (Larkspur-Corte Madera Schools Foundation) Annual Spring Fundraising Gala and approves the request to install two 4’-tall by 7’-wide temporary banner signs as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner signs are permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

April 23, 2019 – May 4, 2019:

- Location #1 – On Redwood Avenue, near Montecito Drive, south of the bus shelter

April 23, 2019 – April 28, 2019:

- Location #2 – On Madera Boulevard, across from Safeway

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (“CEQA”) DETERMINATION

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).
