

**RESOLUTION NO. 07/2014**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA ENDORSING THE LIONS' CLUB CASINO NIGHT FUNDRAISER AND ALLOWING TEMPORARY BANNER SIGNS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM APRIL 4, 2014 TO MAY 18, 2014 AT STAGGERED TIMEFRAMES ADVERTISING CASINO NIGHT AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER ON MAY 17, 2014**

**WHEREAS**, on January 17, 2014, the Lions Club requested permission to place two temporary banner signs in the public right-of-way from April 4, 2014 to May 18, 2014 at staggered timeframes advertising Casino Night at the Community Center on May 17, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lions Club has requested that the Corte Madera Town Council endorse the Casino Night fundraiser; and,

**WHEREAS**, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval to the Town Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the Lions' Club request to endorse Casino Night and approves the request to install 4' by 6' temporary banner signs as shown in Attachment A in the public right-of-way, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner signs are permitted to be displayed per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

April 4, 2014 to May 18, 2014

- 1 on southeast corner of Corte Madera Ave. and Redwood Ave.
- 1 on Tamal Vista Blvd. at the end of Wornum Dr.
- 1 on Redwood Hwy at the end of Wornum Dr.

May 10, 2014 to May 18, 2014

- 1 on Madera Blvd. across from Safeway

2. The applicant shall coordinate with Kevin Kramer, Director of Field Maintenance and Operations, to install and remove the removable hardware and the horizontal banners.
