

**RESOLUTION NO. 26/2014**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA ENDORSING THE MARIN COUNTY LIBRARY AND ALLOWING A TEMPORARY SIGN IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 2014 TO SEPTEMBER 15, 2014 PUBLICIZING THE LIBRARY**

**WHEREAS**, on July 28, 2014, the Corte Madera Library requested permission to place a banner sign in the public right-of-way on Madera Boulevard across from Safeway from September 1, 2014 to September 15, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corte Madera Library has requested that the Corte Madera Town Council endorse the Marin County Free Library, of which the Corte Madera Library is a branch, which is setting up a drive to increase of library card holders in the County; and

**WHEREAS**, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval to the Town Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve Corte Madera Library's request to endorse the Marin County Free Library and approves the request to install a 4' by 7' temporary horizontal banner sign in the public right-of-way as shown in Attachment A, subject to the following conditions:

1. The 4' by 7' banner sign is permitted to be displayed from September 1, 2014 to September 15, 2014 on Madera Boulevard across from Safeway in the public right-of-way.
2. The applicant will pay a \$100 cost recovery fee to the Public Works Department for staff time required to install and remove the removable hardware and the horizontal banner. The fee shall be paid at the Planning Department public counter.

**CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT ("CEQA") DETERMINATION**

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).
