

**RESOLUTION NO. 30/2014**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA  
ENDORING SPARK (LARKSPUR-CORTE MADERA SCHOOLS FOUNDATION) AND  
ALLOWING TWO TEMPORARY SIGNS IN A LANDSCAPED AREA ON PUBLIC  
PROPERTY AND IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM OCTOBER 1, 2014 TO MAY  
31, 2015 ADVERTISING THE SPARK FOUNDATION**

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**WHEREAS**, on October 15, 2014, SPARK (Larkspur-Corte Madera Schools Foundation) requested permission to place one temporary banner sign in the public right-of-way on the southeast corner of Corte Madera Avenue and Redwood Avenue and a second temporary banner on Tamal Vista Blvd. at the end of Wornum Drive to advertise the SPARK Foundation. In addition, SPARK has requested permission to place a temporary sign on a separate occasion in the public-right-of-way on the southeast corner of Corte Madera Avenue and Redwood Avenue and a second temporary banner at Madera Blvd across from Safeway; and

**WHEREAS**, SPARK has requested that the Corte Madera Town Council endorse the SPARK Foundation; and

**WHEREAS**, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval to the Town Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve SPARK's request to endorse the SPARK Foundation and approve the request to install two 4' by 7' temporary signs as shown in Attachment A in the public right-of-way on Corte Madera Avenue and Redwood Avenue and on Tamal Vista Blvd. at the end of Wornum Drive, and on Madera Blvd. across from Safeway, subject to the following conditions:

1. The signs are permitted to be displayed from October 15, 2014 to October 31, 2014 and from February 16, 2015, to February 28, 2015.
2. The applicant will pay a \$350 cost recovery fee to the Planning Department for staff time required to install and remove the removable hardware and signs.
3. The applicant shall coordinate with Kevin Kramer, Director of Public Works Field Maintenance and Operations, to install and remove the removable hardware and signs.

**CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION**

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).
