**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA
RECOGNIZING CORTE MADERA VOTERS AND THE CITIZENS FOR SAVING
PARAMEDIC SERVICES COMMITTEE FOR THEIR EFFORTS IN THE SUCCESSFUL
PASSAGE OF MEASURE I**

WHEREAS, the Town has had in place a Special Paramedic Tax since 1983; and

WHEREAS, this tax must be approved by the voters every four years; and

WHEREAS, the measure was placed on the November 4, 2014, election ballot by the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, Town residents Jana Haehl and Becky Reed founded a grass-roots Citizens for Saving Paramedic Services campaign committee for the purpose of promoting the special tax ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the committee raised funds for the campaign, gathered support for the measure, produced and sent a mailer, walked neighborhoods, posted signs, published a website and Facebook page among other activities; and

WHEREAS, the Corte Madera Firefighters Association and the Marin Professional Firefighters IAFF Local 1775 contributed major funding for the campaign; and

WHEREAS, the Corte Madera voters overwhelmingly approved the measure by 74.88%; and

WHEREAS, the success of the measure was in large part due to the efforts of the committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Corte Madera wishes to recognize the voters of Corte Madera, the Citizens for Saving Paramedic Services committee and specifically Jana Haehl, Becky Reed, the Corte Madera Firefighters Association and the Marin Professional Firefighters IAFF Local 1775, for their actions.
