

**RESOLUTION NO. 34/2013**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA ENDORSING SPARK (LARKSPUR-CORTE MADERA SCHOOLS FOUNDATION) AND ALLOWING ONE TEMPORARY BANNER SIGN IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM OCTOBER 16, 2013 TO OCTOBER 21, 2013 AND A SECOND TEMPORARY BANNER SIGN IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM OCTOBER 21, 2013 TO NOVEMBER 8, 2013 ADVERTISING THE ANNUAL SPARK DONATION DRIVE**

**WHEREAS**, on October 7, 2013, SPARK (Larkspur-Corte Madera Schools Foundation) made a request to place two temporary banner signs in the public right-of-way to advertise the annual SPARK donation drive; and

**WHEREAS**, SPARK has requested that the Corte Madera Town Council endorse SPARK's request; and,

**WHEREAS**, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval to the Town Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve SPARK's request to endorse the annual donation drive and approve the request to install two 4' by 7' temporary banner signs as shown in Attachment A in the public right-of-way on Madera Blvd. across from Safeway and on Tamal Vista Blvd. at the west end of Wornum Drive, subject to the following conditions:

1. One banner sign on Madera Blvd. is permitted to be displayed from October 16, 2013 to October 21, 2013; the other banner sign on Tamal Vista Blvd. is permitted to be displayed from October 21, 2013 to November 8, 2013.
2. The applicant will pay a \$100 cost recovery fee to the Planning Department for staff time required to install & remove each of the two horizontal banners and the removable hardware.
3. The applicant shall coordinate with Kevin Kramer, Director of Field Maintenance and Operations, to install and remove the removable hardware and the two horizontal banners.
