

RESOLUTION NO. 38/2013

RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING CORTE MADERA VOTERS AND THE MEASURE B CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE FOR THEIR EFFORTS IN THE SUCCESSFUL PASSAGE OF MEASURE B

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2013, a special meeting of the Town Council was held to receive a presentation of the 2013 voter survey report by Godbe Research; and

WHEREAS, results from Godbe Research revealed there was an overwhelmingly majority of voter support for a Corte Madera half-cent sales tax measure to pass; and

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2013 the Town Council adopted Resolution No. 28/2013 ordering the submission to the qualified electors of the Town of a sales tax Measure; and

WHEREAS, the Committee developed the Argument in favor of Measure B, created the "*Voter Information Measure B: Local Funding for Corte Madera*" pamphlet which informed residents of the measure; and

WHEREAS, the Measure B Committee was convened with Mayor Furst and Councilmember Ravasio and they both recruited John Howard, Larry Reed, Phyllis Metcalfe, Phyllis Galanis, Jana Haehl, and Bob Bundy, who helped motivate the community and raised needed funds; and

WHEREAS, a total of \$4,650 was raised in a very short amount of time and the Town Council wishes to recognize the Marin Professional Firefighters Political Action Committee, David Bracken, T. J. Quadros, Michael Lappert, Kirby Bartlett, Diane Furst, Bob Ravasio, Jana Haehl and Bob Bundy for their financial contributions; and

WHEREAS, a special recognition goes to Mayor Furst, who worked tirelessly in getting Measure B campaign signs designed, made and posted throughout the town, coordinating tasks with committee members, providing outreach to residents; and

WHEREAS, special recognition also goes to John Howard for handling all accounting and formal paperwork associated with the Measure,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Corte Madera Town Council that it hereby recognizes Corte Madera's voters and the Measure B Committee for their efforts in the successful passage of Measure B.
