

RESOLUTION NO. 3695

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA
ENDORING THE CORTE MADERA WOMEN'S IMPROVEMENT CLUB INDOOR "YARD
SALE" ON MARCH 17, 2012 AND ALLOWING A SIGN IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY
ADVERTISING THE INDOOR "YARD SALE" FROM MARCH 11, 2012 TO MARCH 17,
2012**

WHEREAS, on February 9, 2012, the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club requested permission to place a temporary banner sign in the public right-of-way on Madera Boulevard across from Safeway advertising their Indoor "Yard Sale"; and

WHEREAS, the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club has requested that the Corte Madera Town Council endorse the Indoor "Yard Sale"; and,

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval to the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club's request to endorse the Indoor "Yard Sale" and approves the request to install a 30" by 96" temporary banner sign in the public right-of-way on Madera Boulevard across from Safeway as shown in Attachment A, subject to the following conditions:

1. The banner is permitted to be displayed from March 11, 2012 through March 17, 2012.
2. The applicant shall coordinate with Kevin Kramer, Director of Field Maintenance, to install and remove the removable hardware and the horizontal banner.
