WHEREAS, The Corte Madera Branch Library supports life-long learning and provides up-to-date self-help resources for employment and career searching; and

WHEREAS, The Corte Madera Branch Library partners with MARINet to provide extensive online resources that include the online catalog plus access to thousands of full text articles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Corte Madera hereby proclaims the week of April 8-14, 2012, as "National Library Week" and Tuesday April 11th as National Library Workers Day and joins in observing the week with appropriate activities.


