

RESOLUTION NO. 3708

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA
ENDORING THE PIXIE PARK SPRING FAIR ON MAY 19, 2012, AND ALLOWING A
SIGN IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY ON MADERA BOULEVARD ACROSS FROM
SAFEWAY FROM MAY 4, 2012 TO MAY 19, 2012 ADVERTISING THE PIXIE PARK
SPRING FAIR**

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2012, Pixie Park Spring Fair organizers requested permission to place a banner sign in the public right-of-way on Madera Boulevard across from Safeway from May 4, 2012 to May 19, 2012, advertising the Pixie Park Spring Fair on May 19, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Pixie Park has requested that the Corte Madera Town Council endorse the Pixie Park Spring Fair which is a major fundraising event for this volunteer-run cooperative playground for children age six and under; and,

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval to the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve Pixie Park's request to endorse the Pixie Park Spring Fair and approves the request to install a 4' by 7' temporary horizontal banner sign in the public right-of-way as shown in Attachment A, subject to the following conditions:

1. The 4' by 7' banner sign is permitted to be displayed from May 4, 2012 to May 19, 2012 on Madera Boulevard across from Safeway in the public right-of-way.
2. The applicant will pay a \$100 cost recovery fee to the Public Works Department for staff time required to install and remove the removable hardware and the horizontal banner.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).
