

RESOLUTION NO. 3678

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA
ENDORING THE LARKSPUR LIBRARY ENDOWMENT FUND & FOUNDATION'S WINE
TASTING & AUCTION AND A ALLOWING SIGN IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY
ADVERTISING THE WINE TASTING & AUCTION**

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2011, the Larkspur Library Endowment Fund & Foundation requested permission to install a banner in the public right-of-way to advertise the Wine Tasting & Auction event on November 5, 2011 which will raise funds for the Larkspur Library Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the Larkspur Library Endowment Fund & Foundation has requested that the Corte Madera Town Council endorse the Wine Tasting & Auction fundraising event; and

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the Larkspur Library Endowment Fund & Foundation's request to endorse the Wine Tasting & Auction fundraising event and approves the request to install one horizontal banner to be located in the public right-of-way to advertise the Wine Tasting & Auction fundraising event as shown in Attachment A, provided that the requirements of Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) are fully met and subject to the following conditions:

1. The 3'-tall by 7'-wide horizontal banner is permitted to be displayed from October 10, 2011 through November 7, 2011 at Redwood Highway at the end of Wornum Drive in the public right-of-way.
2. The applicant will pay a \$100 cost recovery fee to the Public Works Department for staff time required to install and remove the removable hardware and the 3' by 7' horizontal banner.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).




