

RESOLUTION NO. 3679

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA
AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF A DISCOUNT FOR LOW INCOME CUSTOMERS
TO THE RATE SCHEDULE THAT IS CURRENTLY IN EFFECT.

WHEREAS, the Town of Corte Madera approved a Solid Waste Management Agreement with Mill Valley Refuse Service (MVRS) effective July 1, 2006 to December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.04.050 of the Corte Madera Municipal Code provides for the establishment of garbage collection rates by resolution; and

WHEREAS, MVRS made a request by letter dated September 8, 2011 that there be available to Town residents meeting certain low income criteria a 20% discount on the collection rates currently in effect for such customers; and

WHEREAS, the proposed discount for customers of low income would be available to customers that qualify for, and participate in, the low income California alternate rates for Energy/Family Electric Rate assistance (CARE/FERA) program offered by Pacific Gas & Electric Company (PG&E); and

WHEREAS, the discount for qualifying customers will be 20% of the current MVRS Residential rates applicable to those residents meeting the low income criteria, in accordance with MVRS' proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Corte Madera grants MVRS' request to make available to residents meeting certain low income criteria a discount on their collection rates, and thereby authorizes the addition of a discount provision for customers of low income effective October 1, 2011, as set forth by Exhibit A, which is attached and incorporated by reference into this resolution.

EXHIBIT A

Low Income Rate Discount

A Low Income Rate is available to residential Single-Family customers who have already qualified for the PG&E CARE/FERA Program. A 20% discount off the applicable residential rate shown on the current rate sheet will apply. A copy of the customer's PG&E bill showing the qualified CARE/FERA Program is required for the discount. To maintain the discounted rate, customers must submit a new PG&E bill annually.
