

RESOLUTION NO. 28/2019

A Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Corte Madera (1) Endorsing the Spark (Larkspur-Corte Madera Schools Foundation) Annual “Fun Run” Fundraiser, (2) Allowing Three Temporary Signs in the Public Right-of-Way from August 7, 2019 Through September 15, 2019 Publicizing the Spark Foundation’s Annual “Fun Run” on September 15, 2019; and (3) Determining that the Project is Exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines 15061(B)(3)

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2019, Spark (Larkspur-Corte Madera Schools Foundation) requested permission to install three temporary banner signs in the public right-of-way from August 7, 2019 through September 15, 2019, publicizing the Annual Spark Fun Run Fundraiser on September 15, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Spark (Larkspur-Corte Madera Schools Foundation) is a non-profit organization that raises funds through events such as the Fun Run to help fund Music, Art, Science, Technology, Engineering, Robotics, and Mindfulness programs at three Corte Madera and Larkspur schools: Cove Elementary, Neil Cummins Elementary, and Hall Middle School; and

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby endorse the Spark (Larkspur-Corte Madera Schools Foundation) Annual Fun Run Fundraiser and approves the request to install three 4’-tall by 7’-wide temporary banner signs as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner signs are permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

August 7, 2019 – September 15, 2019:

- Location #1 – On Tamal Vista Boulevard at the west end of Wornum Drive
- Location #2 – On Redwood Highway at the east end of Wornum Drive

August 16, 2019 – September 15, 2019:

- Location #2 – On Madera Boulevard, across from Safeway

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT(“CEQA”) DETERMINATION

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).
