

RESOLUTION NO. 39/2019

A Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Corte Madera (1) Endorsing the Friends of the Larkspur Library Fundraiser, (2) Allowing Three Temporary Signs in the Public Right-of-Way from October 15, 2019 to November 10, 2019 Publicizing the Friends of the Larkspur Library's "What's It Worth" Fundraiser; and (3) Determining that the Project is Exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines 15061(B)(3).

WHEREAS, on August 20, 2019, the Friends of the Larkspur Library requested permission to install three banner signs in the public right-of-way from October 15, 2019 to November 10, 2019, publicizing the Friends of the Larkspur Library's "What's It Worth" Fundraiser taking place on November 9, 2019 at Larkspur City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the Friends of the Larkspur Library's mission is to raise funds to support the Larkspur Library's enrichment programs and cultural events for children, teens and adults in the Larkspur and Corte Madera communities, and to support the purchase of new books, materials and technology for the Library; with fundraisers such as the "What's It Worth" event contributing its proceeds to fund these efforts; and

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the Friends of the Larkspur Library's request to endorse the Friends of the Larkspur Library's "What's It Worth" Fundraiser and approves the request to install three 4'-tall by 7'-wide temporary banner signs as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner signs are permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

October 15, 2019 – November 10, 2019:

- Location #1 – On the southeast corner of Corte Madera Avenue and Redwood Avenue
- Location #2 – On Tamal Vista Boulevard at the west end of Wornum Drive

October 15, 2019 – October 27, 2019:

- Location #3 – On Madera Boulevard, across from Safeway

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the


environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).


