

RESOLUTION NO. 15/2020

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-21
FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our Town are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Corte Madera must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Corte Madera, will receive an estimated \$189,756 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2020-21 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the fourth year in which the Town of Corte Madera is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the Town of Corte Madera to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Corte Madera has undergone a thorough public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Corte Madera used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the Town of Corte Madera maintain or rehabilitate approximately twenty roads throughout the Town of Corte Madera this year; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the Town of Corte Madera streets and roads are in “fair” condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a “good” condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the Town Council of the Town of Corte Madera, State of California, as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The following list of newly proposed projects will be funded in-part or solely with Fiscal Year 2020-21 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:
