

RESOLUTION NO. 18/2020

A Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Corte Madera (1) Endorsing the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club College Scholarship Program, and (2) Allowing Three Temporary Signs in the Public Right-of-Way from May 11, 2020 to May 18, 2020 Recognizing the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club College Scholarship Recipients of 2020

WHEREAS, on April 20, 2020, the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club requested permission to install three banner signs in the public right-of-way from May 11, 2020 to May 18, 2020, recognizing the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club college scholarship recipients of 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club is a non-profit organization whose mission is to provide college scholarships to college-bound Larkspur and Corte Madera Redwood High School students who have demonstrated an exceptional commitment to community service; and

WHEREAS, the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club would like to publicly congratulate the college scholarship recipients of 2020 in the absence of the Women's Club Scholarship Tea; and

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby endorse the Corte Madera Women's Improvement Club College Scholarship Program and recognizes the recipients of the 2020 scholarships, and approves the request to install three 4'-tall by 7'-wide temporary banner signs as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following condition:

1. The temporary banner signs are permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way in accord with the Banner Location Program and per the following schedule:

May 11, 2020 to May 18, 2020:

- Location #1 – Southeast corner of Corte Madera Avenue and Redwood Avenue
- Location #2 – Madera Boulevard, across from Safeway
- Location #3 – Redwood Hwy., at the East end of Wornum Drive


CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT ("CEQA") DETERMINATION



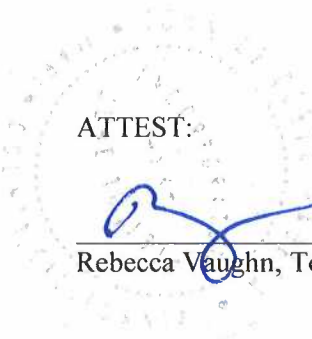
