

**RESOLUTION NO. 34/2020**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA APPROVING A \$75,000 BUDGET AMENDMENT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO HIRE ADDITIONAL SUPPORT TO ENHANCE CODE ENFORCEMENT SERVICES UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE TOWN CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER**

**WHEREAS**, the Town currently provides code enforcement services through our code enforcement officer. The FY 2020/21 budget for code enforcement services is approximately \$120,000, with 20% of those costs being subject to reimbursements; and

**WHEREAS**, the need for code enforcement services continues to grow due to increased code violations, quality of life issues, Town ordinances and support for compliance with fire codes and vegetation management; and

**WHEREAS**, to provide the greatest amount of flexibility and highest level of customer service to constituents in relation to code enforcement services, Town staff is requesting a budget amendment of \$75,000 to hire additional part-time and/or contracted personnel to enhance code enforcement services under the supervision of our Code Enforcement Officer; and


**WHEREAS**, the Town Manager will work with our Code Enforcement Officer to determine the best method of providing code enforcement services, while coordinating with the Central Marin Police Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town believes this additional support will (1) improve service delivery by providing continuity of service; (2) improve the ability to address chronic issues; and (3) further develop cross-functional problem solving using a variety of resources to resolve difficult, complex or chronic code violations and quality of life issues; and


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Council does hereby approve a \$75,000 budget amendment authorizing the Town Manager to hire additional support to enhance code enforcement services under the supervision of the Town Code Enforcement Officer.
