

RESOLUTION NO. 52/2021

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA
(1) ENDORSING THE TWIN CITIES GIRLS SOFTBALL LEAGUE AND (2)
ALLOWING ONE TEMPORARY SIGN IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM
NOVEMBER 17, 2021 TO DECEMBER 15, 2021 PUBLICIZING THE REGISTRATION
PERIOD FOR THE UPCOMING SEASON**

WHEREAS, on November 1, 2021, the Twin Cities Girls Softball League requested permission to install one banner sign in the public right-of-way from November 17, 2021 to December 15, 2021, to publicize the registration period for the Twin Cities Girls Softball League's upcoming season. The registration period begins November 1, 2021 and ends December 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Twin Cities Girls Softball is a recreational Softball League for Corte Madera and Larkspur girls age 5 to 15 years, and has served the community for over 30 years; and

WHEREAS, Twin Cities Girls Softball League's mission is to provide a safe, positive learning environment in which the girls of Twin Cities can learn about and participate in the sport of fast-pitch softball, while also gaining self-esteem, self-confidence and self-discipline; and

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby endorse the Twin Cities Girls Softball League and approves the request to install one 4 foot by 6 foot temporary banner sign as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner sign is permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

November 17, 2021 – December 15, 2021:

Location #1 – Near the bike path entrance, on Tamal Vista Boulevard, at the west end of Wornum
