

**RESOLUTION NO. 25/2022**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA  
ALLOWING THREE TEMPORARY SIGNS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM  
MAY 1, 2022 TO MAY 22, 2022 PUBLICIZING FRIENDS OF THE LARKSPUR  
LIBRARY'S "TOUCH TRUCKS" FUNDRAISER**

**WHEREAS**, on March 27, 2022, the Friends of the Larkspur Library requested permission to install three banner signs in the public right-of-way from May 1, 2022 to May 22, 2022, publicizing the "Touch Trucks" fundraiser on May 22, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, The Friends of the Larkspur Library is a non-profit volunteer-led organization whose mission is to raise funds to support the Larkspur Library's programs, cultural events, books, technology, and materials; and

**WHEREAS**, The Friends of the Larkspur Library is hosting a "Touch Trucks" fundraiser for the following purposes: to raise funds for the proposed Larkspur Library at The Commons; to promote library card signups for children; and to provide a fun and educational event for area children and their families to explore interesting trucks; and

**WHEREAS**, all of the proceeds from the "Touch Trucks" fundraiser will benefit The Commons Foundation, which is a citizen-led 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization whose purpose is to raise private funds from Larkspur and neighboring communities to fund, build, and sustain the City of Larkspur's new library at The Commons at Rose Lane; and

**WHEREAS**, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the request to install three 4'-tall by 7'-wide temporary banner signs as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following condition:

1. The temporary banner signs are permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way in accord with the Banner Location Program and per the following schedule:

May 1, 2022 to May 22, 2022:

- Location #1 – Madera Boulevard, across from Safeway
- Location #2 – On the southeast corner of Corte Madera Ave and Redwood Ave. at Menke Park
- Location #3 – on Tamal Vista Boulevard at the west end of Wornum Drive

**CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT ("CEQA") DETERMINATION**



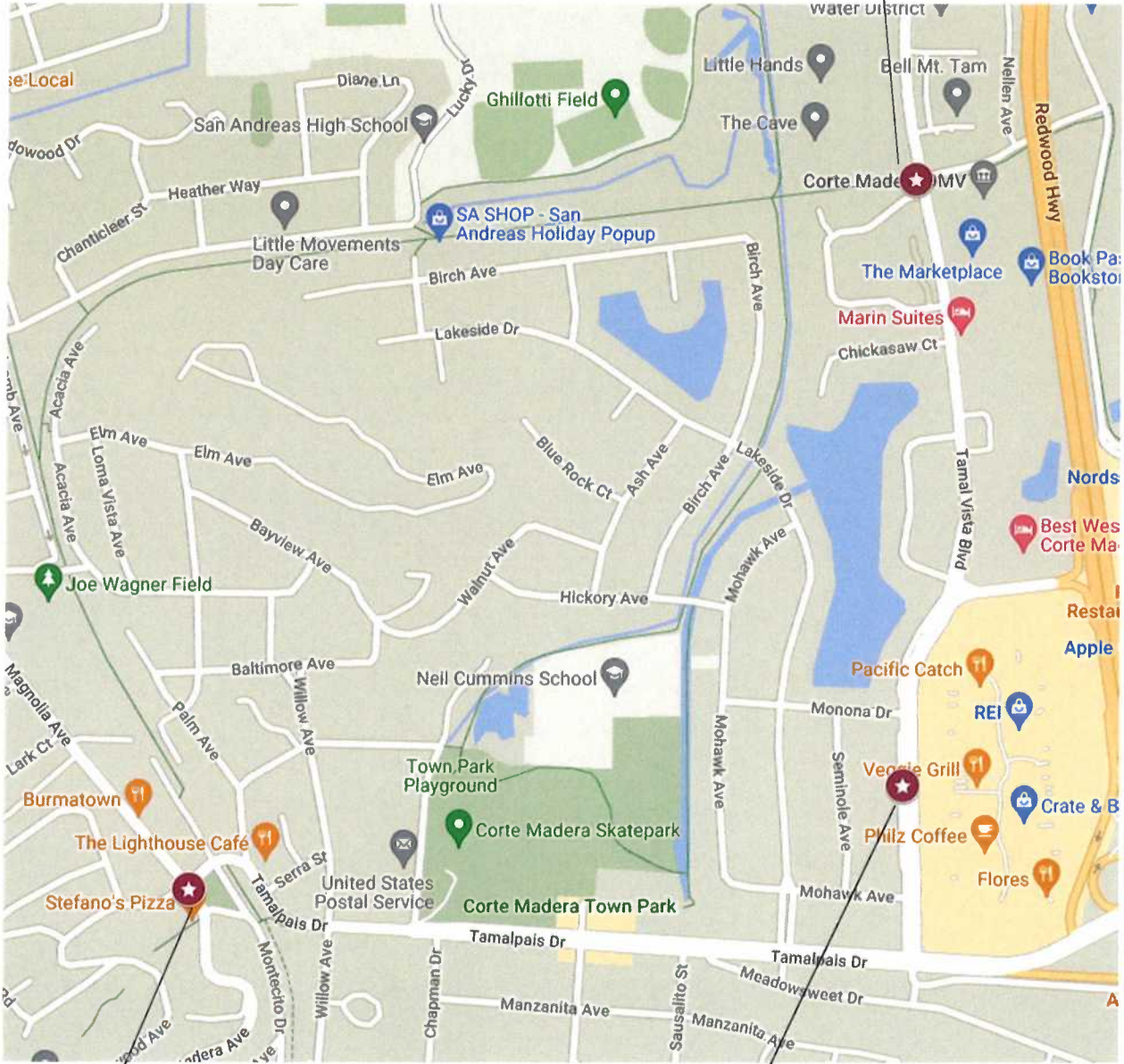
