### TOWN OF CORTE MADERA NOTICE OF A MUNICIPAL ELECTION, MEASURE TO BE VOTED ON, AND NOTICE TO VOTERS OF DATES AFTER WHICH NO ARGUMENTS FOR OR AGAINST A TOWN MEASURE MAY BE SUBMITTED TO THE TOWN CLERK

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a Consolidated General Election is to be held in the Town of Corte Madera on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. At that time, the Town's residents will have the opportunity to vote on their choices to fill three (3) upcoming vacancies on the Town Council. The term of each seat is four (4) years. In addition, the Town Council, pursuant to its rights and authority, does order submitted to the voters at the election the following question:

<i>To maintain rapid 9-1-1 emergency response times and preserve the number of on-duty paramedics ready to respond to accidents/medical emergencies, shall the measure continuing the paramedic services special tax for four years at an annual amount of \$78 per residence and per 1,000 square feet of floor area for nonresidential uses for fiscal years 2023-2024, and thereafter increased \$3 per year up to \$87, generating approximately \$504,400 annually for local paramedic services, subject to annual audits and public spending disclosure, be adopted?</i>	YES

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 2, Division 9 of the State Elections Code, the legislative body of the town, or any member or members thereof authorized by the body, or any individual voter or bona fide associations, may file a written argument to the Corte Madera Town Clerk, 240 Tamal Vista Boulevard, Suite 110, Corte Madera, CA beginning Monday, August 15, 2022 through 5:00 p.m. on Monday, August 22, 2022. Arguments must not exceed 300 words in length, and must be accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) or, if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, for or against the Town measure, and comply with the requirements of Elections Code section 9287(e).

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the Town Council has determined that rebuttal arguments, as submitted by the authors of the opposing direct arguments, must be filed with the Town Clerk beginning Tuesday, August 23, 2022 through 5:00 p.m. Monday, August 29, 2022, and shall not exceed 250 words in length.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that any ordinance, impartial analysis, or direct argument or rebuttal argument filed under the authority of the Election Code will be available for public examination in the Town Clerk's Office, and on the Town's website, <https://www.townofcortemadera.org/562/Elections-Voter-Information>, for not less than 10 calendar days from the deadline(s) for filing arguments and rebuttal arguments. The polls will be open on Election Day, November 8, 2022, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
