UPCOMING TOWN COUNCIL ELECTION, STATUS OF QUALIFIED CANDIDATES, AND MEASURE E

The Town of Corte Madera will hold an Election on November 8, 2022. At that time, the Town's residents will have the opportunity to vote on their choices to fill three (3) upcoming vacancies on the Town Council. The term of each vacancy is four (4) years. At this time, the following individuals are qualified candidates to run in the November 8, 2022 General Municipal Election:

James H. Andrews
Eli H. Beckman
Robert Lucarini
Pat Ravasio
Rosa Thomas

The Town of Corte Madera is also submitting to the voters a ballot measure to extend Corte Madera's parcel tax, which funds paramedic and emergency medical services, from its current June 30, 2023 expiration date until June 30, 2027. The measure will appear on the ballot as Measure E. Measure E would change the tax rate for the parcel tax. The existing tax rate is set at \$75 per year for each residential unit or \$75 per year for each one thousand square feet of nonresidential use. Measure E would increase the tax rates to \$78 per year and allow for \$3 annual increases up to a cap of \$87 per year. The revenue from this special tax – estimated at \$500,000 annually – would continue to be placed in a special fund and used only to fund paramedic and emergency medical services. No other uses of this revenue would be legally permitted.
