**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA
(1) ENDORSING THE TWIN CITIES GIRLS SOFTBALL LEAGUE AND (2)
ALLOWING TWO TEMPORARY SIGNS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM
NOVEMBER 5, 2022 TO DECEMBER 1, 2022 AND ONE TEMPORARY SIGN IN THE
PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM NOVEMBER 11, 2022 TO DECEMBER 1, 2022
PUBLICIZING THE REGISTRATION PERIOD FOR THE UPCOMING SEASON**

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2022, the Twin Cities Girls Softball League requested permission to install two banner signs in the public right-of-way from November 5, 2022 to December 1, 2022, and one banner sign in the public right-of-way from November 11, 2022 to December 1, 2022 to publicize the registration period for the Twin Cities Girls Softball League’s upcoming season. The registration period begins November 1, 2022 and ends January 7, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Twin Cities Girls Softball is a recreational Softball League for Corte Madera and Larkspur girls age 5 to 15 years, and has served the community for over 30 years; and

WHEREAS, Twin Cities Girls Softball League’s mission is to provide a safe, positive learning environment in which Larkspur and Corte Madera girls can learn about and participate in the sport of fast-pitch softball, while also gaining self-esteem, self-confidence and self-discipline; and

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby endorse the Twin Cities Girls Softball League and approves the request to install three 4 foot by 8 foot temporary banner sign as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner signs are permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program, with the following schedule:

November 5, 2022 – December 1, 2022:

- Location #1 – Near the bike path entrance, on Tamal Vista Boulevard, at the west end of Wornum
- Location #2 – On Redwood Highway at San Clemente Drive

November 11, 2022 – December 1, 2022:

- Location #3 – Madera Boulevard, across from Safeway

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION

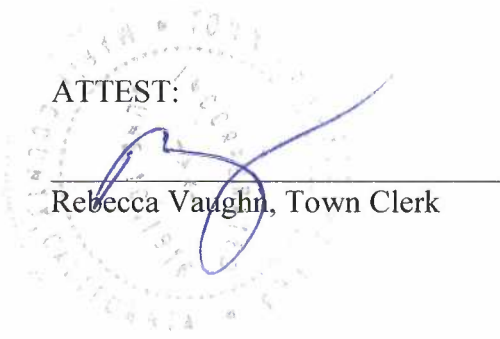
