

**RESOLUTION NO. 57/2022**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA (1) ENDORSING THE MADERA GARDENS NEIGHBORHOOD RESPONSE GROUP DISASTER PREPAREDNESS DRILL, (2) ALLOWING ONE TEMPORARY SIGN IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM OCTOBER 31, 2022 TO NOVEMBER 7, 2022 AND MARCH 6, 2023 TO MARCH 13, 2023 PUBLICIZING THE MADERA GARDENS NEIGHBORHOOD RESPONSE GROUP'S DISASTER PREPAREDNESS DRILLS**

**WHEREAS**, on October 9, 2022, the Madera Gardens Neighborhood Response Group requested permission to install one banner sign in the public right-of-way from October 31, 2022 to November 7, 2022 and March 6, 2023 to March 13, 2023, publicizing the Madera Gardens Neighborhood Response Group's Disaster Preparedness Drills on November 6, 2022 and March 12, 2023, at 10:00 am; and

**WHEREAS**, the Madera Gardens Neighborhood Response Group is a non-profit volunteer-led organization whose goal is to provide resources and training to residents so they can be prepared and self-sufficient in an emergency or disaster; with training such as the Disaster Preparedness Drill an important part of their valuable disaster preparedness programs; and

**WHEREAS**, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the Madera Gardens Neighborhood Response Group's request to endorse the Madera Gardens Neighborhood Response Group's Disaster Preparedness Drill and approves the request to install one 4'-tall by 7'-wide temporary banner sign as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner sign is permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

October 31, 2022 to November 7, 2022; and March 6, 2023 to March 13, 2023:

- Location #1 – on Madera Boulevard, across from Safeway


