

RESOLUTION NO. 61/2022

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACTS OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the Town of Corte Madera, California, on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in General Law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 61/2022 adopted December 6, 2022, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this Town Council, the results are received, attached and made part hereof as "Exhibit A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of ballots cast in the precincts was 5,073

SECTION 2. That the names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the Town Council are as follows:

James H. Andrews
Eli Beckman
Robert Lucarini
Pat Ravasio
Rosa M. Thomas

SECTION 3. That the measures voted upon at the election are as follows:

<i>Shall the special tax for paramedic and/or emergency medical services be continued for four years at an annual amount of \$78 per residence and per 1,000 square feet of floor area for nonresidential uses for fiscal years 2023-2024, and thereafter increased by \$3 per year up to \$87, with anticipated annual revenues of \$504,400, and with the appropriations limit increasing by the amount of the tax, be adopted?</i>	YES

SECTION 4. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the Town to each of the persons above named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates are listed in Exhibit A, as attached.

SECTION 5. The Town Council does declare and determine that: Eli Beckman, Pat Ravasio and Rosa M. Thomas were elected as Members of the Town Council for the full term of four years.

SECTION 6. The Town Council does declare and determine that: As a result of the election, more than two-thirds (2/3) of the voters on this measure did vote in favor of the measure and that the Town Council determines that this measure (Measure E) did pass.

SECTION 7. The Town Clerk shall enter on the records of the Town Council of the Town of Corte Madera, a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of votes (ballots) cast in the Town; (2) The names of the persons voted for; (3) For what office each person was voted for; (4) The measure voted upon; (5) The number of votes given to each person, and for and against each measure.

SECTION 8. The Town Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the Town Clerk and authenticated; that the Town Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the Town Clerk. Each of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.


SECTION 9. The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
