

RESOLUTION NO. 66/2022

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA
(1) ENDORSING THE TIDALWAVES SWIM TEAM AND (2) ALLOWING THREE
TEMPORARY SIGNS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE TIDALWAVES
SWIM TEAM FROM JANUARY 3, 2023 TO FEBRUARY 13, 2023 PUBLICIZING THE
REGISTRATION PERIOD FOR THE UPCOMING TIDALWAVES SWIM SEASON**

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2022, the Tidalwaves Swim Team requested permission to install three banner signs in the public right-of-way from January 3, 2023 to February 13, 2023, publicizing the registration period for the Tidalwaves upcoming season; and

WHEREAS, the Tidalwaves Swim Team is a local non-profit recreational swim team established in 1970, and the Tidalwaves are a community of athletes, coaches, and parent volunteers who are dedicated to providing high-quality swim instruction and a competitive team experience to youth aged 5 to 18 in Larkspur and Corte Madera; and

WHEREAS, the Tidalwaves Swim Team’s mission is to promote the ideals of good sportsmanship, fair play, self-esteem, achievement, and team spirit to participants of all abilities; and

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby endorse the Tidalwaves Swim Team and approves the request to install three 4’-tall by 7’-wide temporary banner signs as shown in Attachments A and B, subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary banner signs are permitted to be displayed in the public right-of-way per the Banner Location Program per the following schedule:

January 3, 2023 – February 13, 2023:

- Location #1 – On Madera Blvd. across from Safeway
- Location #2 – On Tamal Vista Blvd. at the West end of Wornum Dr.
- Location #3 – On Redwood Hwy. at the East end of Wornum Dr.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT(“CEQA”) DETERMINATION




