

RESOLUTION NO.45/2015

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA ENDORSING THE CORTE MADERA CENTENNIAL COMMITTEE'S 2016 EVENTS AND APPROVING TEMPORARY BANNERS ON THE PREVIOUSLY APPROVED EIGHT LIGHT POST LOCATIONS AND FOUR ADDITION LIGHT POST LOCATIONS FROM JANUARY 1, 2016 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2016 (EXCEEDING THE 50 DAY MAXIMUM); AND DETERMINING THAT THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES 15061(B)(3)

WHEREAS, on October 9, 2015, the Centennial Committee requested permission to place 12 temporary banners in the public right-of-way; eight of the locations are the preapproved light poles – six on San Clemente Drive, one in front of the Fire Station on Tamalpais Avenue and one at Redwood Avenue and Montecito Drive; and the four additional locations are at the intersection of San Clemente Drive and Redwood Highway, the southern entrance of the Town Center and Tamalpais Avenue, on the north side of Tamalpais Drive between Town Hall and Menke Park (in front of 206 Tamalpais Drive), and the light pole in front of Bank of America (663 Tamalpais Drive); and

WHEREAS, the Centennial Committee has requested that the banners be display beyond the 50 day maximum from January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Centennial Committee has requested that the Corte Madera Town Council endorse the Centennial events; and,

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such banners with the approval to the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the Centennial Committee's request to endorse the events and approves the request to install 12 vertical banners as shown in Attachments 2 and 3 of the staff report in the public right-of-way in the following locations:

1. Six on San Clemente Drive,
2. One in front of the Fire Station on Tamalpais Avenue,
3. One at Redwood Avenue and Montecito Drive
4. One at the intersection of San Clemente Drive and Redwood Highway
5. One at the southern entrance of the Town Center and Tamalpais Avenue.
6. One on the north side on Tamalpais Drive between Town Hall and Menke Park (in front of 206 Tamalpais Drive) and
7. One on the light pole in front of Bank of America (663 Tamalpais Drive)

subject to the following conditions:

1. The banners are permitted to be displayed from January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016.
2. The applicant shall coordinate with Kevin Kramer, Director of Field Maintenance and Operations, to install and remove the necessary hardware for the 4 new locations.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).
