

RESOLUTION NO. 40/2015

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA ENDORSING THE CORTE MADERA CENTENNIAL'S NEW YEAR'S EVE PARTY AND ALLOWING TEMPORARY SIGNS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM OCTOBER 21, 2015 TO DECEMBER 9, 2015 ADVERTISING THE NEW YEAR'S EVE PARTY AND DETERMINING THAT THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES 15061(B)(3)

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2015, the Centennial Committee requested permission to install banners in the public right-of-way to advertise the New Year's Eve party; and

WHEREAS, the Centennial Committee has requested that the Corte Madera Town Council endorse the New Year's Eve party; and,

WHEREAS, Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) permits such signs with the approval of the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corte Madera Town Council does hereby approve the Centennial Committee's request to endorse the New Year's Eve party and approves the request to install three horizontal banners to be located in the public right-of-way to advertise the New Year's Eve party as shown in Attachments A and B, provided that the requirements of Corte Madera Municipal Code Section 18.22.050(10)(A) are fully met and subject to the following conditions:

1. All of the banners shown in Attachment A are permitted to be displayed from October 21, 2015 to December 9, 2015.
2. The 3' by 7' horizontal banners will be installed and removed by the Public Works Department utilizing the removable hardware at the locations shown on the map in Attachment B.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT("CEQA") DETERMINATION

The activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment (CEQA, Article 5, Section 15061(b)(3)).
