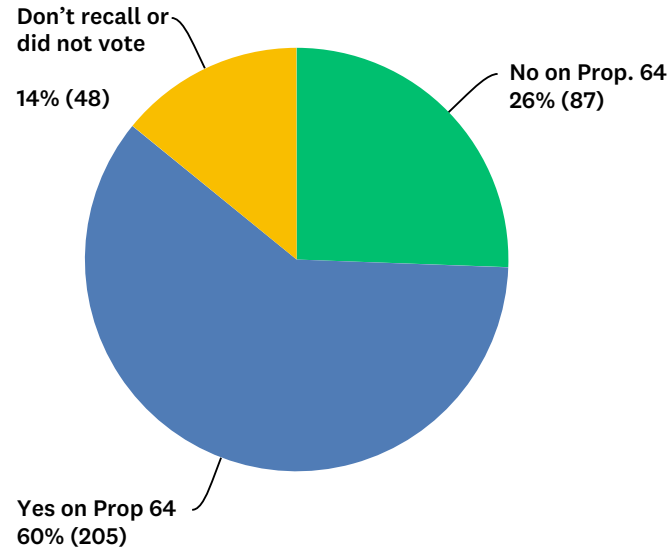

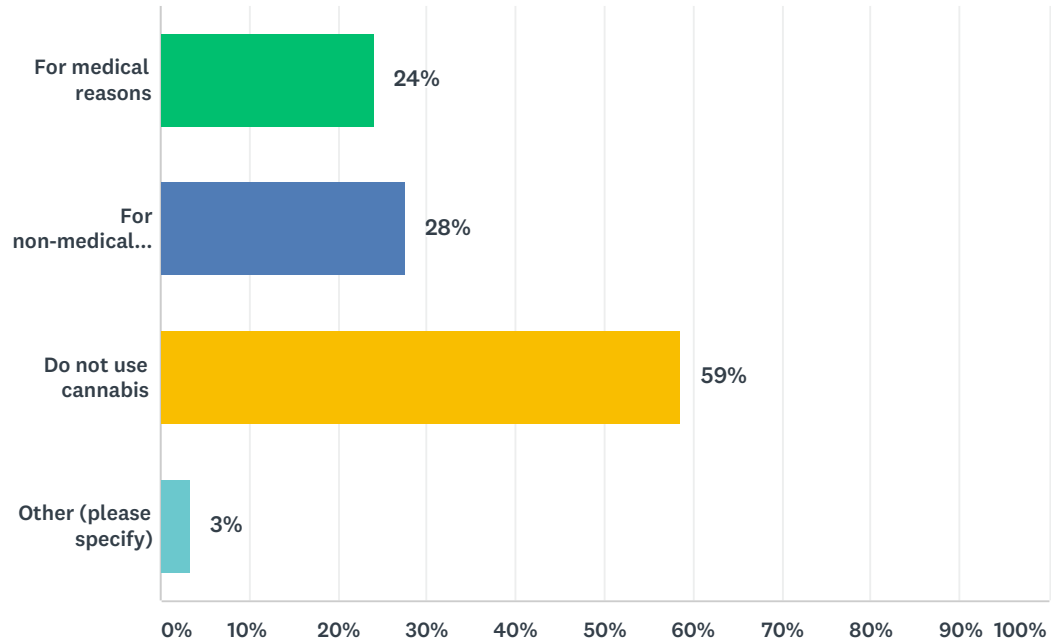

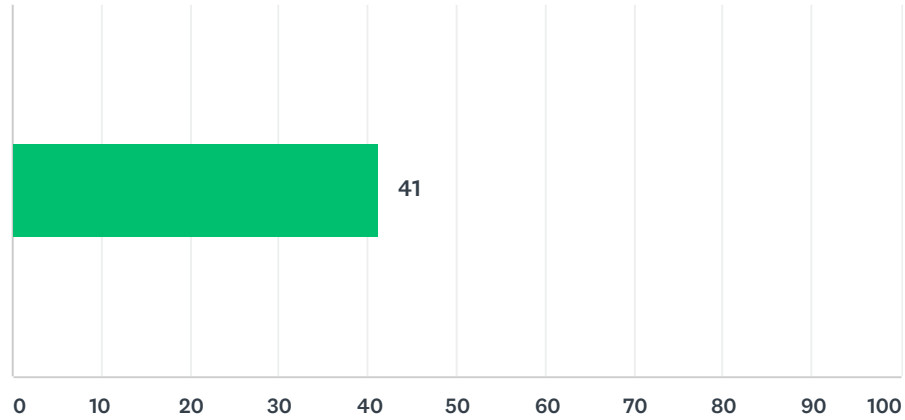

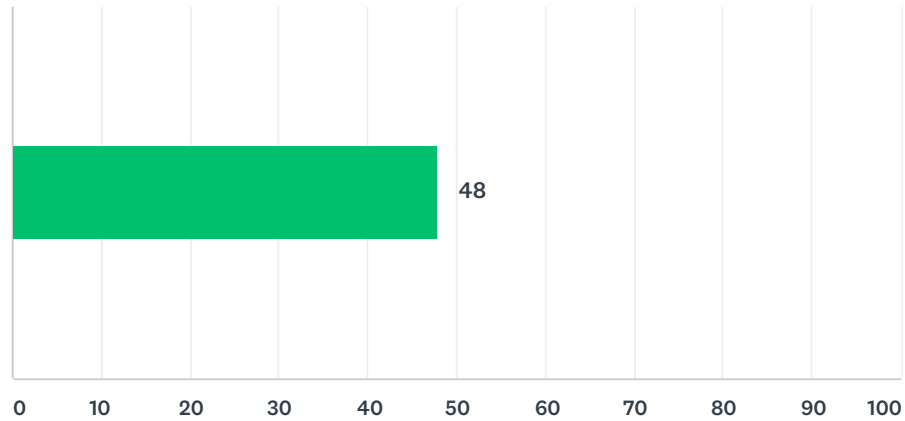

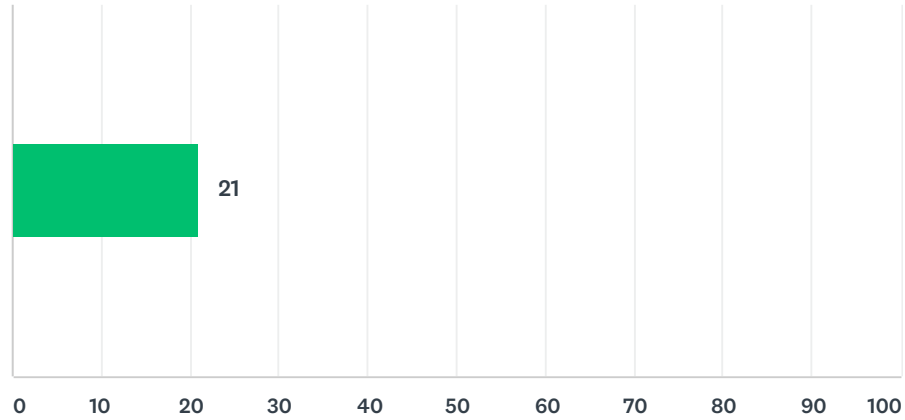

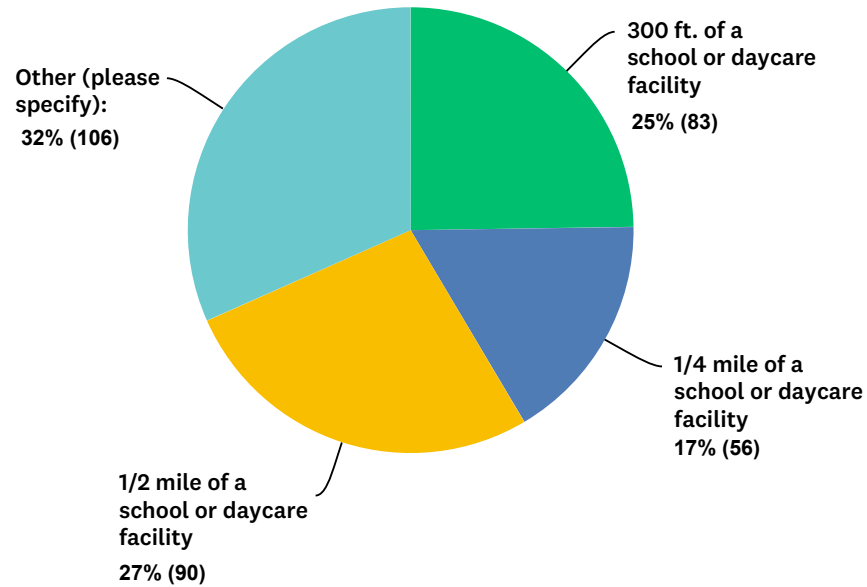

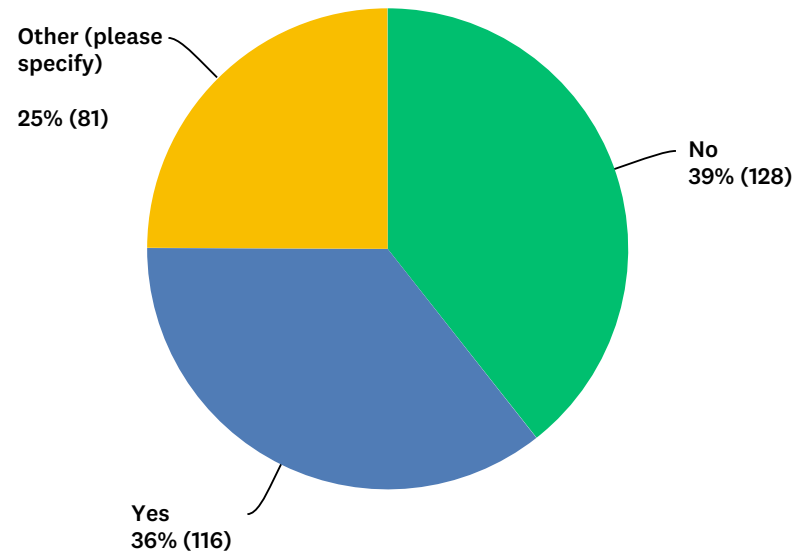

Here are some highlights: A study published in the American Journal of Public Health found that 2014 saw a 6.5 percent reduction in deaths resulting from opioid abuse in Colorado, indicating a reversal of the previous 14-year increasing trend. A think tank working for Washington's state legislature produced a report showing overall decreases in youth cannabis usage rates. The report was based on survey data from the state's Department of Health, which polled for usage among students in grades six, eight, ten, and twelve. The results of the survey showed decreased usage by students in all four grade levels. For example, students in the tenth grade responded at a 17 percent usage rate in 2016, compared to rates of 18 percent in 2006, and 20 percent in 2010. Similar decreases in teen usage were observed in Colorado, with 21.2 percent reporting usage in 2015, down from 22 percent in 2011. Bottom line: if something is scarce, people want it, and they will do whatever they need to do to get it.
