### What is being planned?

Caltrans has prepared an IS/ND for the U.S. Highway 101 (U.S. 101) Tamalpais Drive Overcrossing Project (Project). The Project is located in Corte Madera, Marin County, on U.S. 101 at post mile (PM) 7.37. The Project proposes to upgrade the structure over U.S. 101 at Tamalpais Drive Overcrossing (OC) by replacing the existing nonstandard pedestrian facilities with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant features. The Project also includes seismic structural improvements, intersection modifications, reconfiguration of the U.S. 101 on/off-ramps, and repairs and maintenance of the existing structure

### Why this advertisement?

Caltrans, as the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), has prepared the IS/ND to analyze potential effects the proposed Project may have on the environment. This notice is to inform you of the public comment period.

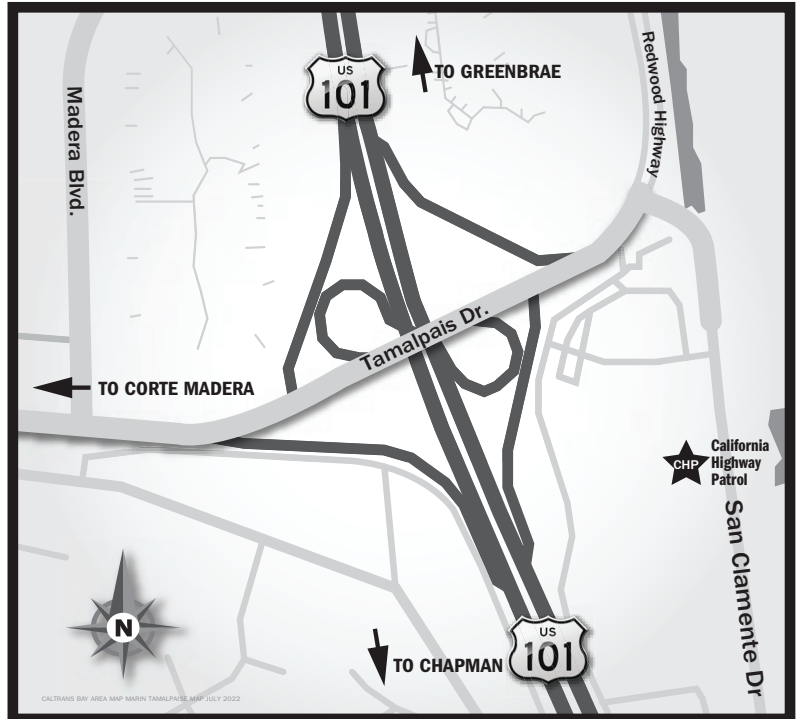
